"(c) Developing options to cap rent increases and limit the fre quency of rent increases; and

"(d) Identifying advocacy resources available to manufactured home
 owners facing displacement due to rent increases.

"(3) The task force may collaborate with public and private entities
 as needed to fulfill the duties described in subsection (2) of this sec tion.

"(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a
 quorum for the transaction of business.

"(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a

recommendations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to affordable housing as appropriate no later

5 "(11) The Housing and Community Services Department shall pro6 vide staff support to the task force.

"(12) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-7 islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-8 bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by 9 them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and 10 amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in 11 performing functions of the task force shall be paid out of funds ap-12 propriated to the Housing and Community Services Department for 13 purposes of the task force. 14

15 "(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, 16 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties 17 and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to 18 furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force 19 consider necessary to perform their duties.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31,
2016.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
