## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 612

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "dyslexia" insert "; and declaring an emergency".

3 Delete lines 4 through 26 and insert:

4 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Education shall develop a plan
5 to:

6 "(a) Ensure that every student who is first enrolled at a public 7 school in this state for kindergarten or first grade receives a screening 8 for risk factors of dyslexia; and

9 "(b) Provide guidance for notifications sent by school districts to
10 parents of students who are identified as being at risk for dyslexia
11 based on a screening of risk factors.

"(2) The plan required under subsection (1) of this section must be developed collaboratively with experts on dyslexia, including representatives of nonprofit entities with expertise in issues related to dyslexia.

"(3) When developing the plan required under subsection (1) of this
 section, the department shall identify screening tests that are cost
 effective and that screen for the following factors:

19 "(a) Phonological awareness;

20 "(b) Rapid naming skills;

21 "(c) The correspondence between sounds and letters; and

1 "(4) The department shall submit a report on the plan required 2 under subsection (1) of this section, and any proposed legislation, to 3 the interim legislative committees on education no later than Sep-4 tember 15, 2016.

5 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31,
6 2016.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Each school district shall ensure that at least one
teacher per school has received training related to dyslexia. The
training must:

"(a) Comply with the knowledge and practice standards of an
 international organization on dyslexia;

"(b) Enable the teacher to understand and recognize dyslexia; and
"(c) Enable the teacher to implement instruction that is systematic,
explicit and evidence-based to meet the educational needs of students
with dyslexia.

16 "(2) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission shall adopt 17 rules to ensure that training that meets the standards described in 18 subsection (1) of this section satisfies professional development re-19 quirements.

20 "(3) Training described in subsection (1) of this section may be re-21 ceived from online sources.

"(4) A school district that does not comply with the requirements
 of this section is considered nonstandard under ORS 327.103.
