PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 751

- After line 2 of the printed bill, insert:
- 2 "Whereas organ, eye and tissue donation in Oregon has saved hundreds
- 3 of lives and given sight, mobility and a better quality of life to thousands
- 4 more; and
- 5 "Whereas the State of Oregon, through the Department of Transportation,
- 6 has a decades-long relationship with designated organ procurement organ-
- 7 izations, in which the department invites customers to join the anatomical
- 8 donor registry and have a 'D' placed on their driver license or identification
- 9 card; and
- "Whereas nearly 2.3 million Oregonians are part of the anatomical donor
- 11 registry, 98 percent of whom joined the registry through contact with the
- 12 department; and
- "Whereas further outreach to and education of Oregonians will lead to
- 14 even greater participation in the donor registry, resulting in more lives
- saved, sight given and lives improved; now, therefore,".
- Delete lines 18 through 30 and insert:
- "SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Transportation shall accept
- donations of \$3 or more for the Organ Donor Registry and Public
- 19 Awareness Fund established under section 1 of this 2015 Act whenever
- 20 a person:
- 21 "(a) Applies for a driver permit, driver license or identification card;
- 22 **or**

- "(b) Renews a driver permit, driver license or identification card.
- "(2) The form a person must use to apply or renew as described in subsection (1) of this section must notify the person of the option to donate to the fund.
- "(3) After deducting the expenses for collecting and transferring a donation under this section, the department shall transfer the moneys to the fund.
 - "SECTION 3. (1) A person that applies online for the renewal of vehicle registration may donate to the Organ Donor Registry and Public Awareness Fund established under section 1 of this 2015 Act. The Department of Transportation shall maintain, on its vehicle registration renewal website and online application form, a link to the website of the organ procurement organization that has established a donor registry in this state, as described in section 1 of this 2015 Act, for the purpose of redirecting the person to a website that accepts donations for deposit into the fund.
 - "(2) The vehicle registration renewal website and online application form must notify the person of the option to donate to the fund.
 - "SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2015 Act becomes operative July 1, 2019.".
