## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 865

1 Delete lines 4 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Fire service professional' and 'police officer' have the
meanings given those terms in ORS 181.610.

5 "(b) 'Homestead' means real or personal property that is an 6 owner-occupied primary residence.

"(c) 'Surviving spouse' means the spouse of a fire service professional or police officer killed in the line of duty.

9 "(2) A county may provide, by ordinance or resolution, that the first 10 \$250,000 of assessed value of the homesteads of surviving spouses lo-11 cated in the county shall be exempt from all taxes, fees, charges and 12 assessments imposed on the homesteads.

"(3)(a) A surviving spouse seeking the exemption granted under this
 section must file an application with the county assessor on or before
 April 1 preceding the first property tax year for which the exemption
 is sought.

17 **"(b) The application must:** 

18 "(A) Be made on a form prescribed by the Department of Revenue;

19 "(B) Designate the property for which the exemption is claimed;

"(C) Include a statement setting forth the basis for eligibility for
 the exemption; and

1 affirming that all information contained in the application is true.

"(c) A timely application shall be approved if all requirements for
the exemption are met.".

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
