"(2) A health care provider shall make a report of abuse, in accordance with ORS 419B.015, if the provider receives from a patient a
confidential communications request, as defined in section 2 of this
2015 Act, and the patient:

11 "(a) Is an unemancipated minor under 19 years of age; and

12 "(b) The patient states in the confidential communications request 13 that disclosure of all or part of a communication regarding the patient 14 may lead to harassment or abuse of the patient or may undermine the 15 patient's ability to access health care.

"[(1)] (3) Upon notice by a law enforcement agency, the Department of Human Services, a member agency of a county multidisciplinary child abuse team or a member of a county multidisciplinary child abuse team that a child abuse investigation is being conducted under ORS 419B.020, a health care provider must permit the law enforcement agency, the department, the member agency of the county multidisciplinary child abuse team or the member of the county multidisciplinary child abuse team to inspect and copy medical records, including, but not limited to, prenatal and birth records, of the child involved in the investigation without the consent of the child, or the parent or guardian of the child. A health care provider who in good faith disclosed medical records under this section is not civilly or criminally liable for the disclosure.
