## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2571

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 6, before "storage" insert "use,".
- Delete lines 9 and 10 and insert:

- 3 "(b) The policies and procedures described in paragraph (a) of this sub-4 section must include:
- "(A) A requirement that a recording be retained for at least 180 days but no more than 30 months for a recording not related to a court proceeding, or for the same period of time that evidence is retained in the normal course of the court's business for a recording related to a court proceeding.
  - "(B) A requirement that the camera be set to record continuously, beginning when a law enforcement officer develops reasonable suspicion or probable cause to believe that a crime or violation has occurred, is occurring or will occur and the law enforcement officer begins to make contact with the person suspected of committing the offense. The policies and procedures must also require that the camera may subsequently cease recording no sooner than the termination of the officer's participation in the contact.
- "(C) A requirement that in any contract with a third party vendor for data storage, recordings from the camera are the property of the law enforcement agency, are not owned by the vendor and cannot be used by the vendor for any purpose inconsistent with the policies and procedures of the law enforcement agency.
- "(D) A prohibition on the use of facial recognition or other biometric matching technology to analyze recordings obtained through the use of the

- "(E) A prohibition on the use of any recordings obtained from the camera for any purpose other than a legitimate law enforcement purpose.
- "(c) Notwithstanding paragraph (b)(B) of this subsection, a law enforcement agency may in its policies and procedures provide for exceptions to the
- 6 recording requirements of paragraph (b)(B) of this subsection, provided that
- 7 the exceptions are based on reasonable privacy concerns, exigent circum-
- 8 stances or the safety of law enforcement officers or other persons.".
- On page 2, line 36, after "unless" insert a colon and delete the rest of the line and lines 37 and 38 and insert:
  - "(i) The officer has an opportunity to announce at the beginning of the interaction that the conversation is being obtained; and
- "(ii) The announcement can be accomplished without causing jeopardy to the officer or any other person and without unreasonably impairing a criminal investigation; or".
- On page 10, delete line 2 and insert:
- "(A) The recording is used as evidence in a court proceeding and has not been sealed in the court's record of the proceeding; or".
- 19 After line 4, insert:
  - "(b) A public body that provides a copy of a recording under paragraph
    (a) of this subsection must require that, prior to any disclosure of the recording, the identity of persons other than law enforcement officers in the
    recording be made visually unrecognizable unless the person in the recording
    has consented to the disclosure in writing.".
- In line 5, delete "(b)" and insert "(c)".
