"<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Environmental Quality Commission shall submit
 the revisions specified in section 1 of this 2015 Act to the United States
 Environmental Protection Agency no later than _____.

19 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Department of Environmental Quality shall re-20 port to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 21 192.245 within 60 days after the United States Environmental Pro-22 tection Agency acts on the revisions specified in section 1 of this 2015 Act. If the agency approves the revisions, the department shall include in the report any recommendations for legislation the department deems advisable.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".
