"(3) A person who is designated to produce marijuana under ORS

"(a) For a marijuana growsite located outdoors, nine pounds of us able marijuana per mature marijuana plant; or

"(b) For a marijuana growsite located indoors, three pounds of usable marijuana per mature marijuana plant.".

"(b) Upon request, the authority may provide the address of a 22marijuana processing site or a medical marijuana dispensary that is 23stored in the database developed and maintained under this section to 24a law enforcement agency or to the governing body of a city or county. 25"(c) Except for the address where a marijuana processing site or 26medical marijuana dispensary is located, the authority may not pro-27vide to a law enforcement agency, or to the governing body of a city 28or county, any personally identifiable information stored in the data-29 base developed and maintained under this section.". 30
