"(4) The unexpended balances authorized to be expended by the 3 Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for 4 a four-year period beginning July 1, 2015, from revenues dedicated, $\mathbf{5}$ continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made available 6 for the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions 7 and powers transferred from the Department of Community Colleges 8 and Workforce Development to the Higher Education Coordinating 9 Commission by the amendments to statutes by sections 1 to 99 of this 10 2015 Act by acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, equipping 11 and furnishing buildings, structures, land and other projects at com-12 munity colleges pursuant to section 6(2) to (5), (8), (9), (11) and (14), 13 chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, and sections 3 (1) and 4, chapter 120, 14 Oregon Laws 2014, are transferred to and are available for expenditure 15 by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the four-year 16 period specified for the purpose of administering and enforcing the 17 duties, functions and powers transferred by the amendments to stat-18 utes by sections 1 to 99 of this 2015 Act.". 19
