PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 942

On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete line 28 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert: "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall enter into an agreement with the Oregon Historical Society under which the society shall solicit donations and undertake a fund-raising campaign to raise moneys for:

"(a) The selection of a sculptor or sculptors and the commission of
the designs and the production of the sculptures of Chief Joseph and
Abigail Scott Duniway, including the creation of pedestals and any
desired inscriptions;

"(b) The transportation of the statues and pedestals to the United
 States Capitol;

"(c) The temporary display of the statues in the Rotunda of the
 United States Capitol during any unveiling ceremony to be held;

14 "(d) Other costs associated with the unveiling ceremony;

15 "(e) The removal of the statues of Jason Lee and John McLoughlin 16 from National Statuary Hall in the United States Capitol, transporta-17 tion of the Jason Lee and John McLoughlin statues to Oregon and 18 installation of the Jason Lee and John McLoughlin statues in suitable 19 locations identified by the Oregon Heritage Commission; and

20 "(f) Any other expenses the society incurs in implementing the 21 terms of the agreement under this subsection.

22 "(2) Upon entering into the agreement described in subsection (1)

of this section, the Executive Director of the Oregon Historical Society
 or the director's designee shall:

"(a) Facilitate meetings of the society for the purpose of undertaking the duties described in subsection (1) of this section;

5 "(b) Within six months following enactment of this 2015 Act, write 6 to the Architect of the Capitol apprising the architect of the interest 7 of the State of Oregon in replacing the statues of Jason Lee and John 8 McLoughlin in National Statuary Hall of the United States Capitol 9 with statues of Chief Joseph and Abigail Scott Duniway and requesting 10 the architect to seek the approval of the Joint Committee on the Li-11 brary of Congress for the statues' replacement; and

"(c) Convey all information received from the Architect of the Capitol about the statue replacement project to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or their designees.

"(3) As soon as is practicable after the date on which the society 16 determines that it has obtained sufficient funding to undertake the 17 project described in subsection (1) of this section, the society shall 18 seek proposals from qualified sculptors and direct the executive di-19 rector to undertake whatever other measures are necessary to com-20plete the project described in subsection (1) of this section. The society 21and the executive director shall follow the direction of the Architect 22of the Capitol in completing the project described in subsection (1) of 23this section. 24

"(4) The Oregon Heritage Commission shall seek applications from representatives of venues in this state that wish to provide places of honor for the statues of Jason Lee and John McLoughlin. The commission shall make the final selection of venues and shall inform the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or their designees, of the selected places of honor. "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, to be transferred to the Oregon Historical Society for the purpose of funding the agreement described in section 1 of this 2015 Act.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
