PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2354

1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 14 through 37 and 2 insert:

3 "SECTION 11. ORS 837.380 is amended to read:

"837.380. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a person
who owns or lawfully occupies real property in this state may bring an
action against any person or public body that operates [a drone] an unmanned aircraft system that is flown [at a height of less than 400 feet] over
the property if:

9 "(a) The operator of the [*drone*] **unmanned aircraft system** has flown 10 the [*drone*] **unmanned aircraft system** over the property [*at a height of less* 11 *than 400 feet*] on at least one previous occasion; and

"(b) The person notified the owner or operator of the [drone] unmanned
aircraft system that the person did not want the [drone] unmanned aircraft system flown over the property [at a height of less than 400 feet].

¹⁵ "(2) A person may not bring an action under this section if:

"(a) The [*drone*] unmanned aircraft system is lawfully in the flight path
 for landing at an airport, airfield or runway[;] and

"[(b)] the [drone] unmanned aircraft system is in the process of taking
off or landing[.]; or

"(b) The Federal Aviation Administration has authorized the use
 of the unmanned aircraft system and the unmanned aircraft system
 is operated in accordance with the terms and conditions of the au-

1 thorization.

"(3) A prevailing plaintiff may recover treble damages for any injury to the person or the property by reason of a trespass by [a drone] **an unmanned aircraft system** as described in this section, and may be awarded injunctive relief in the action.

6 "(4) A prevailing plaintiff may recover attorney fees under ORS 20.080 if 7 the amount pleaded in an action under this section is \$10,000 or less.

8 "(5) The Attorney General, on behalf of the State of Oregon, may bring 9 an action or claim for relief alleging nuisance or trespass arising from the 10 operation of [*a drone*] **an unmanned aircraft system** in the airspace over 11 this state. A court shall award reasonable attorney fees to the Attorney 12 General if the Attorney General prevails in an action under this section.".
