PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3400

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "marijuana;" delete the rest of

2 the line and lines 3 through 5 and insert "; and declaring an emergency.".

3 Delete lines 7 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 33 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. As used in sections 1 to 4 of this 2015 Act:

5 "(1) 'Limited marijuana retail product' means:

6 "(a) The dried leaves and flowers of marijuana; or

7 "(b) A marijuana plant that is not flowering.

"(2) 'Marijuana' means the plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae, any
 part of the plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae and the seeds of the
 plant Cannabis family Cannabaceae.

"SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a medical marijuana facility registered under ORS 475.314 may sell limited marijuana retail products to a person who is 21 years of age or older if:

"(a) The person presents proof of age to the medical marijuana fa cility at the time of the sale;

"(b) The medical marijuana facility verifies that the person is 21
years of age or older at the time of the sale; and

"(c) The medical marijuana facility is located within the jurisdiction
 of a city or county that has not adopted an ordinance prohibiting sales
 as described in this subsection.

22 "(2) For purposes of this section, proof of age may be substantiated

by presenting to a registered medical marijuana facility acceptable
 proof of age adopted by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission by
 rule.

4 "(3) The Oregon Health Authority and the commission shall enter 5 into an agreement under which the commission may conduct an onsite 6 inspection of the premises where a registered medical marijuana fa-7 cility is located to ensure that the medical marijuana facility is in 8 compliance with applicable provisions of law or rules as described in 9 section 4 of this 2015 Act.

10 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a 11 marijuana grow site registered under ORS 475.304 may sell limited 12 marijuana retail products to a medical marijuana facility registered 13 under ORS 475.314 for purposes described in section 2 of this 2015 Act 14 if:

"(a) The person responsible for the marijuana grow site under ORS
475.304 obtains the consent of the registry identification cardholder for
whom the person responsible for the marijuana grow site produces or
processes the limited marijuana retail products;

"(b) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, the person responsible for the marijuana grow site applies to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission in a form and manner prescribed by the commission; and "(c) The commission determines that the person responsible for the marijuana grow site is qualified to sell limited marijuana retail products to a registered medical marijuana facility for purposes described in section 2 of this 2015 Act.

"(2) For purposes of this section, obtaining consent as described in
 subsection (1)(a) of this section constitutes an assignment of the right
 to possess the limited marijuana retail products.

"(3) In prescribing the form and manner of making an application
 under subsection (1)(b) of this section, the commission shall require

1 an applicant to complete an online application.

2 "(4) If the commission determines that an applicant under this 3 section is qualified to sell limited marijuana retail products to a reg-4 istered medical marijuana facility for purposes described in section 2 5 of this 2015 Act, the commission shall provide the applicant with a 6 certificate that verifies that the applicant is qualified to sell limited 7 marijuana retail products to a registered medical marijuana facility.

8 "(5) The commission may conduct an onsite inspection of the 9 premises where an applicant or holder of a certificate produces or 10 processes marijuana under this section to ensure that the applicant 11 or holder of the certificate is in compliance with applicable provisions 12 of law or rules as described in section 4 of this 2015 Act.

"SECTION 4. (1) A medical marijuana facility registered under ORS 13475.314 that makes sales of limited marijuana retail products as de-14 scribed in section 2 of this 2015 Act is subject to any applicable pro-15vision of sections 3 to 70, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, or any rule 16 adopted under sections 3 to 70, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, related 17 to the regulation of a person who holds a license under section 22, 18 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, including any provision or rule related 19 to the imposition of a tax on the sale of limited marijuana retail pro-20ducts by a person who holds a license under section 22, chapter 1, 21Oregon Laws 2015. 22

"(2) A marijuana grow site registered under ORS 475.304 that makes 23sales of limited marijuana retail products as described in section 2 of 24this 2015 Act is subject to any applicable provision of sections 3 to 70, 25chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, or any rule adopted under sections 3 to 2670, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, related to the regulation of a person 27who holds a license under section 19, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, 28including any provision or rule related to the imposition of a tax on 29 the production or processing of limited marijuana retail products by 30

3 "SECTION 5. Sections 1 to 4 of this 2015 Act are repealed on De4 cember 31, 2016.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.".
