"(b) 'Claw' means a hardened, keratinized modification of the epidermis, or a hardened, keratinized growth extending from the end of the digits, of certain mammals, birds, reptiles or amphibians, commonly referred to as a claw, talon or nail.

"(c) 'Declaw' means to remove, or to prevent the normal function of, a claw of an animal by a surgical procedure such as onychectomy, tendonectomy or phalangectomy.

"(d) 'Devocalize' means to remove, or to prevent the normal function of, the vocal cords of an animal by a surgical procedure such as vocal cordectomy, debarking, devoicing, silencing, ventriculocordectomy, bark reduction or bark softening. 1 "(2) A person may not devocalize an animal unless:

2 "(a) The person performing the procedure is a licensed veterinarian;

3 "(b) Anesthesia is administered to the animal during the procedure; and
