On <u>page 1</u> of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and line 3 and insert "and declaring an emergency.".

4 Delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

5 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Except as provided by subsections (2) and (3) of 6 this section, a school district may not receive State School Fund dis-7 tributions under ORS 327.013 for a student who:

"(a) Has satisfied the requirements for a high school diploma, as
provided by ORS 329.451 (2);

10 "(b) Remains enrolled at a school district; and

"(c) Has enrolled in one or more college-level courses offered
 through a community college or a public university listed in ORS
 352.002.

"(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section prevents a school district from receiving State School Fund distributions for a student who:
"(a) Has not been in grades 9 through 12 for more than a total of
four years; or

"(b) Has been in grades 9 through 12 for more than a total of four
years because the student:

"(A) Has not satisfied the requirements for a high school diploma,
as provided by ORS 329.451 (2);

1 extended diploma; or

"(C) Has satisfied the requirements for a modified diploma or an
extended diploma but has not satisfied the requirements for a high
school diploma, as provided by ORS 329.451 (2).

"(3) A school district may receive State School Fund distributions
for a student described in subsection (1) of this section if, prior to June
1, 2015, the student had enrolled in an educational program offered by
the school district for the 2015-2016 school year.

9 "(4) Nothing in this section prohibits a school district from:

"(a) Expending moneys related to the education of students de scribed in subsection (1) of this section, as long as the school district
 does not receive State School Fund distributions for that purpose; or

13 "(b) Entering into agreements with community colleges or public 14 universities to provide college-level courses to students of the school 15 district and paying for the tuition, fees or books for those courses with 16 State School Fund distributions, as long as the courses are not pro-17 vided to students described in subsection (1) of this section.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies to the 2015-2016
 school year.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
