HB 5203 Capital Construction

On February 25th, the Capital Construction Subcommittee voted to recommend passage of HB 5203, with amendments.

HB 5203 is the budget bill for Capital Construction projects. The bill establishes authority for the planning, design, and construction of projects with costs over \$1 million. Each project must be authorized by the Legislature. Some of the projects are funded with bond proceeds provided in HB 5202.

Project approvals and expenditure limitations expire six years after being authorized. Projects approved in this bill will expire on June 30, 2021. The bill also changes the amounts of some of the projects approved during the 2015 session.

The budget report lists a description of the capital construction projects and the expenditure limitation amounts.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 5203 be amended by the -3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
