## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4050

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30.
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 30 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) The Policy Advisory Council on Summer Learning
- 4 is created for the purpose of ensuring, on or before January 1, 2022,
- 5 that all children from prekindergarten through grade 12 are provided
- 6 meaningful access to summer education programs.
- 7 "(2) The council shall consist of members who are jointly appointed
- 8 by the Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction, the President of
- 9 the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the State
- 10 Librarian. An appointment may include a member who satisfies more
- than one of the qualifications for membership listed in subsection (3)
- of this section.
- 13 "(3) Membership of the council shall include, but is not limited to:
- "(a) Two members from the House of Representatives;
- 15 "(b) Two members from the Senate; and
- 16 "(c) A representative of:
- 17 "(A) The State Library;
- 18 "(B) The Office of the Governor;
- 19 "(C) The Chief Education Office;
- 20 "(D) The Department of Education;
- 21 "(E) The Oregon School Boards Association;

- "(F) The Confederation of Oregon School Administrators;
- 2 "(G) The Oregon Parent Teacher Association;
- 3 "(H) The Oregon Education Association;
- 4 "(I) A statewide network consisting of public and private organiza-
- 5 tions and community members that focuses on services and programs
- 6 for children when they are not in school; and
- "(J) A community-based organization that provides summer pro-8 grams in Oregon.
- 9 "(4) To accomplish the purpose described in subsection (1) of this 10 section, the council shall:
- "(a) Compile and evaluate information related to summer education programs available throughout this state to create a baseline with which to compare future program offerings; and
- 14 "(b) Develop policy recommendations, including recommendations 15 for legislation, to the Legislative Assembly.
- 16 "(5) The recommendations described in subsection (4)(b) of this 17 section shall:
- "(a) Support education programs and curricula to educate public school students throughout the state and achieve the educational goals of this state as described in ORS 350.014;
- 21 "(b) Support programs designed to provide rigorous academic 22 learning and enrichment;
  - "(c) Incorporate best practices established from research conducted on summer education programs;
- 25 "(d) Include strategies for maximizing investment through private 26 and public partnerships with community-based organizations;
- 27 "(e) Identify and propose solutions to address transportation needs 28 and barriers to access;
- 29 "(f) Align with the economic needs of local communities;
- 30 "(g) Include, but are not limited to, programs in which access is

- 2 "(h) Be compatible with existing after-school programs; and
- "(i) Begin by addressing schools that serve areas with the highest poverty and that also present the following:
- 5 "(A) Lowest performing test scores;
- 6 "(B) Lowest graduation rates; and
- 7 "(C) Highest chronic absentee rates.
- 8 "(6) The Legislative Administration Committee shall provide staff 9 support to the council.
  - "(7) Members of the council who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in performance of their official duties in the manner and amounts provided in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in performing functions of the council shall be paid out of funds appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee for purposes of the council.
- 17 "(8) The council shall:
  - "(a) Report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly relating to education concerning its policy recommendations no later than September 15, 2016.
  - "(b) Submit a report, including recommendations described in subsection (4)(b) of this section, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly relating to education no later than December 1, 2016.".
