Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 257 A

Modifies crime of official misconduct in the first degree to include commission of official misconduct in the second degree when public servant is aware of and consciously disregards risk that violation places vulnerable person in danger of physical injury or of being victim of sex crime or causes withholding of necessities from vulnerable person.

SB 323 A

Creates crime of arson incident to the manufacture of a controlled substance in the second degree if person manufactures controlled substance and causes fire or explosion that damages building or damages property in amount exceeding \$750.

SB 751 A

Prohibits form of marriage application, license or record from requiring address for entity authorized to solemnize marriage.

SB 846 A

Prohibits use of physical restraints in juvenile court proceedings on youth, youth offender or young person with exceptions.
