### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 714 A

Allows court to include reasonable residency restrictions as special condition of probation for person convicted of stalking or violating court's stalking protective order.

SB 895

Expands eligibility for Family Sentencing Alternative Pilot Program to include defendants who are pregnant or who have custody of child at time of sentencing.

SB 1055

Expands definition of "deployment" or "deployed" to include "mobilization" of member of Armed Forces, National Guard or reserve component in specific laws affecting certain family law judgments.

### Work Session

SB 64 A

Renames "mental disease or defect" to "qualifying mental disorder" in criminal and certain juvenile statutes.

SB 95 B

Requires certain securities professionals to report suspected financial exploitation of vulnerable persons to Department of Consumer and Business Services.

SB 492

Permits parties to judgment that contains spousal support award to request required exchange of certain documents without filing request for modification of judgment with court.

SB 890 A

Provides that disclosure of legally privileged city information and records to elected city auditor does not waive privilege with respect to any other person, to extent information and records are disclosed for purpose of audit or investigation.
