- HB 3078 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Modifies eligibility for Family Sentencing Alternative Pilot Program.
- HB 3454  
Describes actions school districts are required to take or are prohibited from taking regarding students who are unable to pay for meals.
- HB 3461  
Provides Attorney General with increased enforcement authority over contraband cigarette sales in conjunction with nonparticipating manufacturer adjustment settlement related to tobacco Master Settlement Agreement.

- HB 2131 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to railroads that own or operate high hazard train routes in this state.
- HB 3434  
Extends sunset date for public safety fiscal emergency program for counties.
- HB 3456  
Permits establishment of photovoltaic solar power generation facility on certain high-value farmland.
