SB 419 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/9/2017 AGENDA: Creates Hospital Rate Commission in Oregon Health Authority to review hospital charges billed by certain hospitals and recommend to Oregon Health Authority whether to approve charges as reasonable based on prescribed criteria.

Work Session

HB 2267

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/9/2017 AGENDA: Provides exemption from requirement to obtain medical imaging license if person uses sonographic equipment for sole purpose of ophthalmic sonography.

SB 754

Creates offense of selling tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems to person under 21 years of age.

Public Hearing

SB 50

Requires certain health care professionals and persons holding certificate of certified alcohol drug counselor to complete pain management education once every four years.

SB 816

Permits Oregon Health Authority to require hospitals to submit emergency department abstract records, in addition to ambulatory surgery and inpatient discharge abstract records.

SB 861

Removes, for health care facilities that receive preponderance of revenue from associated comprehensive group-practice prepayment health care service plans, exemption from financial data reporting required by Oregon Health Authority for other facilities.

SB 856

Allows naturopathic physicians to perform certain actions that physicians are authorized to perform.
