SB 819

Expands parameters of duties and responsibilities of Critical Incident Response Team assigned by Department of Human Services upon becoming aware of fatality of child that was result of abuse or neglect.

SB 268 **

Requires Department of Human Services and law enforcement agencies to investigate reports of abuse that occurred at school or in educational setting or that are made by school employees.

SB 246

Sets forth circumstances under which Department of Human Services may immediately suspend, revoke or place conditions on license, certification or other authorization of child-caring agency.
