#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 821  
Directs Oregon Housing Stability Council, with advice of Community Action Partnership of Oregon, to develop policy for awarding grants to organizations that shall use funds in Emergency Housing Account to align with federal strategies and resources available to prevent and end homelessness.
- SB 949  
Makes noncompetition agreement with home care worker voidable by home care worker.
- SB 942  
Directs Department of Human Services to conduct statewide study regarding child safety no later than July 1, 2018.
- SB 263  
Limits school district's ability to require students to participate in abbreviated school day program.

#### Work Session

- SB 104  
Modifies provisions relating to registry of persons who provide care in certain facilities.
- SB 140 \*\*  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Youth Authority for gang intervention services in Multnomah County. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 834  
Requires Department of Human Services to develop and present proposal for creation of human rights commission to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services and health no later than September 1, 2017.
