#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 101 A  
Authorizes child abuse investigation on school premises.
- SB 327  
Provides recreational immunity to owner of land.
- SB 690  
Establishes procedures for applying for Certificate of Good Standing eligibility certification and for petitioning for and issuing Certificate of Good Standing.
- SB 894 \*\*  
Modifies eligibility for Family Sentencing Alternative Pilot Program. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 896  
Defines terms related to appeals.
- SB 967  
Provides that youth offenders sentenced to mandatory minimum terms of imprisonment for certain crimes committed at 15, 16 or 17 years of age are eligible for conditional release hearing if they are in custody of Oregon Youth Authority upon attaining 24 years and six months of age.

#### Work Session

- SB 64  
Renames "mental disease or defect" to "qualifying psychiatric or developmental condition" in criminal and certain juvenile statutes.
- SB 497  
Defines "arrest," for purposes of procedures to file motion to set aside record of arrest, to mean action by law enforcement officer or prosecuting attorney that results in official record that person is alleged to have committed offense.
