Pvt. Gilbert, 24 rears of age, is the son of Mr, and Mrs. Alfred Gilbert, West Glens Falls. He is a graduate of Glens Falls High School, class of 1939, and prior to his induction into the Army was employed by the Marinette Paper Co., South Giens Falls.

Inducted into the Army on October 8, 1943, Pvt. Gilbert was given his basic training at Camp Croft. S. C., before being shipped overseas in April of this year. Stationed in England after his arrival overseas, Pvt. Gilbert invaded the continent shortly after D-Day with an infantry unit and was captured by the Germans on June 19.
