Trillium is a strong, community-based health care system focused on prevention and delivering high-quality care that integrates physical, behavioral and oral health services.

We are:

Our mission: A healthier community

Since 2012, Trillium has invested more than \$12 million in our local community to:

- Increase access to care by providing grants to open five new primary health clinics
- Collaborate with Lane County in the co-location of physical and behavioral health services throughout our service area and establish Trillium-funded staff at Lane County Public Health
- Invest \$1.33 per member per month for prevention services to improve the health of the community we serve
- Integrate and enhance behavioral health services; assist with access to housing, education and healthy food
- Offer online parenting classes and strength-based, family interventions
- Work closely with the local early learning hub, Lane Early Learning Alliance, to ensure children are safe, healthy and enter school ready to learn
