The Nine veteran organizations that make up the United Veterans' Groups of Oregon (UVGO) are in unanimous support of SB 694. This legislation will increase the tax exemption for property tax for our most deserving disabled veterans or surviving spouses.

Military Officer's We hope that Oregon can follow Alabama, Arkansas, Hawaii, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia and Washington where a totally disabled veteran may receive a full property tax exemption if the veteran receives 100% disability compensation from the VA and a rating of 100% disabled un-employability. At the same time, we hope Oregon will increase the tax exemption limit for those veterans that are rated between 40 and 90% SC Disability.
