 - One public member who is not engaged in professional real estate activity, is not state certified
 or licensed and does not have a direct financial interest in a person certified or licensed, not
 employed by financial institutions or mortgage bankers (WALKER)
- Maximum of two terms
- Serve at the pleasure of the Governor

- Operate as semi-independent state agency
- Regulate the activities of state-licensed appraisers and state certified appraisers
- Certify, license and supervise state certified and state licensed appraisers

- Ensure all real estate appraisals conform to the law
- Issue subpoenas and compel witnesses for proceedings before the board
- Adopt rules, establish educational requirements, professional code of responsibility and rules to register out-of-state appraisers
- Set and collect annual registry fees; adopt budgets
- Sue and be sued in its own name
- Report to Governor and Legislative Assembly at beginning of each regular session regarding specified activities of the board (required of all semi-independent state agencies)
