Term of office for members appointed by the Governor is four years

Majority of voting members of the council is a quorum for transaction of business

Members include:

- Governor or Governor's designee, as a nonvoting member (GOLDFARB)
- Director or director's designee of the following agencies as nonvoting members
 - Department of Environmental Quality (PETTIT)
 - Department of Fish and Wildlife (BRABY)
 - Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (MCCONNELL)
 - Department of Land Conservation and Development (KLARIN)
 - Division of State Lands (CASTELLI)
 - Parks and Recreation Department (WOOD)
 - Department of Agriculture (HOBBS)
 - On behalf of the State Board of Higher Education, the director or director's designee of Oregon State University, Sea Grant College (HOLDREN)
 - Federal Agency Liaison (LOHRMAN)
- A member of the governing body of Coos, Curry, Douglas or Lane County (**MAIN**)
 - Appointed by the Governor, chosen in consultation with and with the approval of a majority of the members of the governing bodies of Coos, Curry, Douglas and Lane Counties
- A member of the governing body of Clatsop, Lincoln or Tillamook County (THOMPSON)
 - Appointed by the Governor, chosen in consultation with and with the approval of a majority of the members of the governing bodies of Clatsop, Lincoln and Tillamook Counties
- An elected city official from a coastal city bordering the territorial sea (ALLEN)
 - Appointed by the Governor with advice from an Oregon coastal zone management association
- A representative of each of the following ocean interests – appointed by the Governor, subject to Senate confirmation
 - Commercial ocean fisheries of the North Coast from Newport north (McMULLEN, Astoria)
 - Commercial ocean fisheries of the South Coast from south of Newport (PETTINGER, Brookings)

- Charter, sport or recreation ocean fisheries of the North Coast from Newport north (HOLLOWAY, Portland)
 - Charter, sport or recreation ocean fisheries of the South Coast from south of Newport (**HEAP Jr., Brookings**)
 - Ports Marine navigation or transportation (Vacant)
 - Coastal nonfishing recreation interests of surfing, diving, kayaking or windsurfing (PLYBON)
 - A coastal conservation or environmental organization (HARTMANN)
 - Oregon Indian tribes appointed after consultation with the Commission on Indian Services (FLIER)
 - A coastwide organization representing a majority of small ports and local governments – nonvoting member (GODDARD)
 - A statewide conservation or environmental organization (CARTER)
- Two representatives of the public, at least one of whom shall be a resident of a county bordering the territorial sea – appointed by the Governor (**POSTLEWAIT Jr.,** vacant)

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 196.438-196.471

- Voting members of the council shall elect a person from among the membership to chair the council
- Meet once every six months
- Periodically review the Territorial Sea Plan and submit recommendations for the plan to state agencies represented on the council
- Advance policies of ORS 196.420 (Ocean Resources Management) to the federal government and any multistate bodies
- Provide a forum for discussing ocean resource policy, planning and management issues
- Recommend amendments to the Oregon Ocean Resources Management Plan as needed
- Offer advice to the Governor, the State Land Board, state agencies and local governments on specific ocean resources management issues
- Encourage participation of federal agencies in discussion and resolution of ocean resources planning and management issues affecting Oregon
- Ocean Policy Advisory Council may not, except to the extent of fulfilling specific advisory capacity, establish fishing seasons, harvest allocations, geographic restrictions or other harvest restrictions
- Establish project review panels to address and coordinate interests of the state, federal and local governments in specific development proposals
- Adopt guidelines to establish criteria to create review panels
