 - 2 members from other apprenticeable occupations that have programs approved and registered with the council, including one member representing employers and one member representing employees (ARANDA, **POPMA**)
 - o 3 members representing the public (BETTS, DAVIS, GARDNER)
- To qualify for the position, individuals shall provide the Governor with documentation showing that they meet at least one of the following requirements:
 - o Active participation on an apprenticeship governing body for a minimum of four years; or
 - o A minimum of 4 years of experience in workforce development/investment activities, vocational training/education, apprenticeship program administration or a related discipline.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 660.110 & 660.120

- Rulemaking; enforcing the provisions of ORS chapter 660
- With assistance of director and director's staff, conduct investigations, issue subpoenas, obtain evidence, administer oaths and take testimony in matters related to its duties
- Establish policy of the apprenticeship program to encourage promotion, expansion and improvement of programs
- Cooperate with interested state and federal agencies and other training providers, such as community colleges, educational service districts, and recognized industry programs
- Approve and register program standards submitted by appropriate local joint committees
- Establish committees and approve nominations of members and alternates to local and state joint committees to ensure a balanced representation of employer and employee groups
- De-register standards, terminate programs and remove members of any committee for inactivity or inadequate activity, failure to abide by the provisions of Chapter 660
