WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds ten new designees to the list of those required to coordinate emergency preparedness and response with the Office of Emergency Management.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

[-1 amendment] Adds Oregon Travel Information Council to the list.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon law currently requires 22 entities to designate an individual with the authority to allocate resources, to liaise with the Office of Emergency Management regarding emergency preparedness and response. Senate Bill 61 adds ten more designees from the following: the Department of Education, the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, the Department of State Lands, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Employment Department, Oregon Housing and Community Services, Oregon Business Development Department, the Military Department, the Tourism Commission, and the Secretary of State's office.
