BACKGROUND:

The East Metro Gang Enforcement Team is an interagency team focused on combating gang activity in east Multhomah County. It includes members from the Fairview, Troutdale, and Gresham city police departments and the Multhomah County Sheriff's Office.

Senate Bill 140 appropriates \$2,341,057 from the General Fund to the Oregon Youth Authority for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017 for the East Metro Gang Enforcement Team, and permits the funds to be spent on other gang intervention services in east Multhomah County.
