Testimony on House Bill 2732

Chair Barker and members of the committee:

My name is Kohana Jade Clem. I am the daughter of Rep. Brian Clem and Carol Suzuki. I am a member of Girl Scout Troop 10037. I am 9 years old and I am in the 3rd grade. I live in Salem, Oregon and a lot of my other Girl Scouts sisters do too. This is my first time testifying on a bill.

I am in favor of House Bill 2732. I want this bill to pass because it will help save children and animals lives. The bill puts clear rules in place so people will know what to do and know that they are protected by the law.

If you see a child or an animal in a dangerous situation and hurting like in a hot car.

The rules are:

- 1) You see if the owner of the car is close by.
- 2) If they are not, check to see if the doors are unlocked or if a window is cracked.
- 3) If it is not, first call the police to make sure you have permission to break open a window.
- 4) Only break one window.

In the United States, there are 7 other states that have passed bills like House Bill 2732 with support from both Democrats and Republicans. They are: California, Florida, Massachusetts, Ohio, Tennessee, Vermont and Wisconsin.
