**Measure Description:**

Authorizes issuance of Article XI-Q bonds to finance seismic and life safety improvements to State Capitol building and grounds.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon State Treasurer, Bonding, Legislative Administration Committee (LAC)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill authorizes issuance of Article XI-Q bonds to be used for seismic and other safety improvements to the State Capitol building and grounds. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of the impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
