

SB 5504

Department of Aviation

SB 5504 is the budget bill for the Department of Aviation. The Department promotes, develops, and improves Oregon's aviation system. It manages and maintains 28 state-owned airports, performs safety inspections of Oregon's 97 public-use airports, and registers all pilots and non-military aircraft based in Oregon. The agency is supported by aviation fuel taxes and pilot, aircraft, and airport registration fees.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends a budget of \$12,230,778 Other Funds and \$4,516,499 Federal Funds for a total biennial budget of \$16.75 million, including 15 positions (14.25 FTE). The Subcommittee also recommends adoption of the agency's Key Performance Measures as presented.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends SB 5504 be amended by the –2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
