### **Measure Description:**

Requires Department of Education to be responsible for providing education of students for first 30 calendar days after eligible day treatment program or eligible residential treatment program begins operations or expands operations to different school district.

#### Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires the Department of Education to provide the education of a student for the first 30 calendar days after an eligible day treatment program or an eligible residential treatment program begins operations or expands operations to a different school district. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. The bill does not designate a funding source for the payments required in the bill.
