

Please oppose SB719. This bill opens up unconstitutional infringements on people's right to bears arms, rights to be free from unreasonable search and seizure, and their right to due process. The amendments proposed to this legislation could easily be abused by people who are upset with someone else, not requiring any real proof of a crime or dangerous intent; It would only require someone's opinion to be persuasive before the court, with no real evidence, resulting in the seizure of legally owned property.
