

Health Share Pathways

- Network of specialty mental health and substance use providers
- Managed by a partnership of the 3 counties
- Governed by an integrated steering committee with physical and behavioral health plan partners



Better Care via Pathways

Before **Now** (with Health Share Pathways) Administratively cumbersome for provider Centralized region-wide network for MH and SUD services with standardized: contracting Three separate county-based provider Payment networks limited member choice Utilization management Provider credentialing System of care for members w/co- Provider contracting occuring conditions was bifurcated because of funding Mutualized risk for all behavioral health Different payment arrangements and services across county partners (funding utilization management requirements was follows the member need) an administrative burden and an obstacle to transformation

Health Share and the Tri-Counties

- Counties provide vital safety net services for the entire community
- OHP eligibility fluctuates, and many members receive county behavioral health services during times when they do not qualify for OHP
- Braiding OHP funding with County General funds facilitates a strong safety net that serves those with specialty behavioral health needs regardless of OHP eligibility

Building a collaborative system of care:

- Regionalization
- Centralization
- Standardization



Regionalization

Regionalized behavioral health plan functions:

- Budget
- Risk pool
- Provider network
- Collaborative decision-making



Centralization

Behavioral health plan functions centralized at Health Share:

- Provider contracting and credentialing
- Network management
- Up Next: Central compliance functions



Standardization

Behavioral health plan functions standardized across the three counties:

- Payment rates
- Utilization management guidelines
- Up Next: building and expanding alternative payment mechanisms



The Work Ahead

- Mismatch: workforce and member needs
- Provider payment inequality
- Integration and achieving a "no-wrong-door" system
- Long-term investment in prevention and early life health
 - Suicide prevention
 - Opioid epidemic
- Developing a community-based peer workforce
