Marion County Integrated Health System WHAT'S WORKING?

HB 3650 (2011) WRITTEN AGREEMENTS

- 414.153. Partnering with county government. In order to make advantageous use of the system of public health care and services available through county health departments and other publicly supported programs and to insure access to public health care and services through contract under ORS chapter 414, the state shall:
- (4) Recognize the responsibility of counties under ORS 430.620 to operate community mental health programs by requiring a written agreement between each coordinated care organization and the local mental health authority in the area served by the coordinated care organization.

- Health Department Directors are county board designees and attend all meetings, serve on committees


