WHAT'S WORKING?

HB 3650 (2011) WRITTEN AGREEMENTS

414.153. **Partnering with county government.** In order to make advantageous use of the system of public health care and services available through county health departments and other publicly supported programs and to insure access to public health care and services through contract under ORS chapter 414, the state shall:

(4) Recognize the responsibility of counties under ORS 430.620 to operate community mental health programs by **requiring a written agreement between each coordinated care organization and the local mental health authority** in the area served by the coordinated care organization.

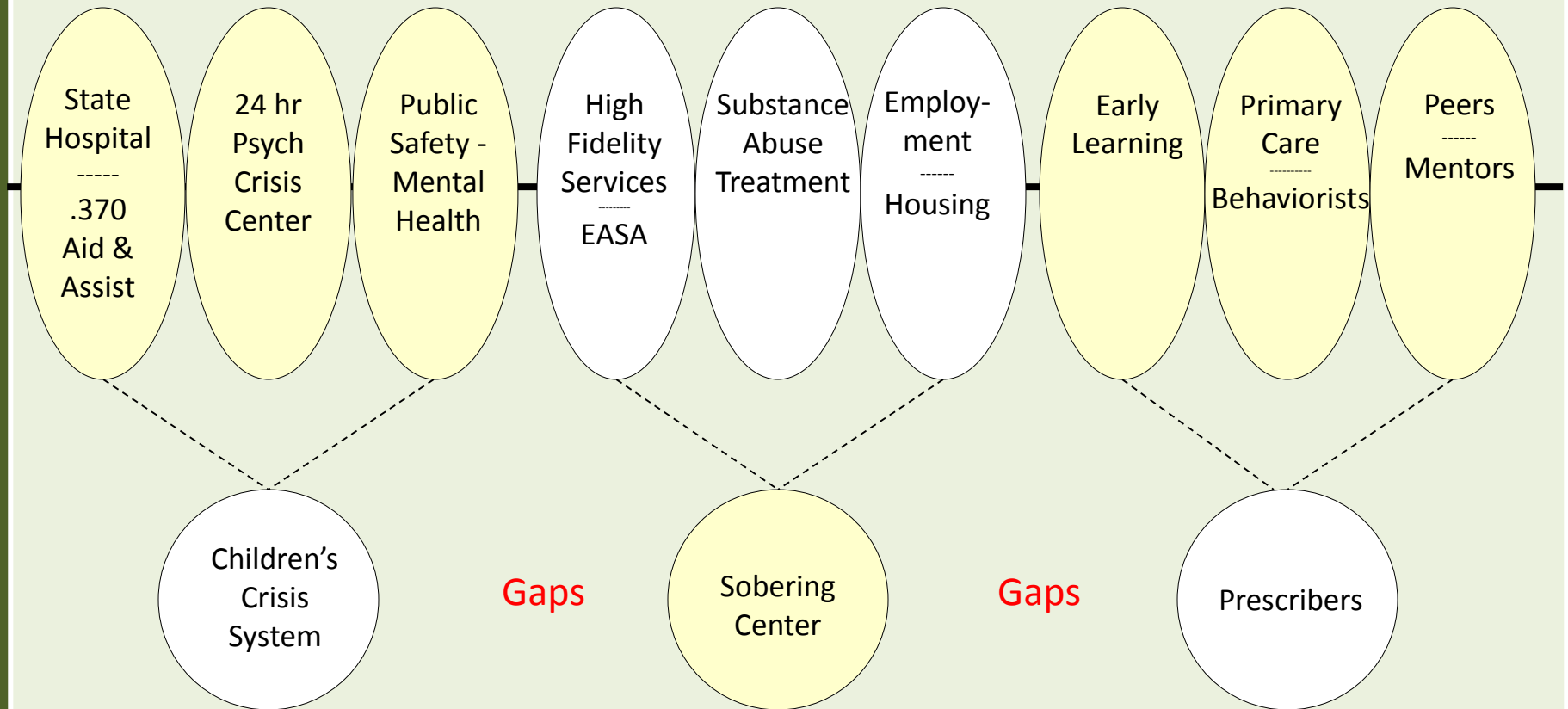

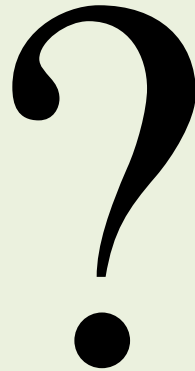

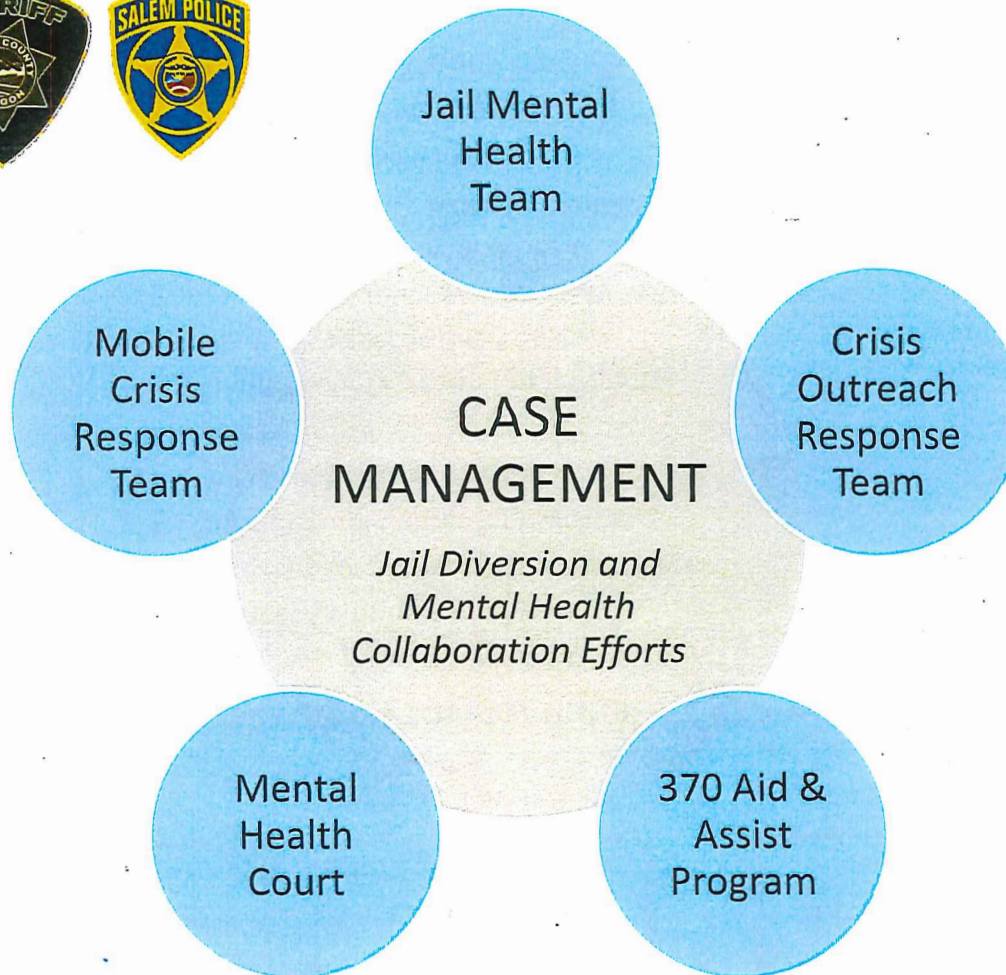

Results:

Mobile Crisis calls in 2015: **710**, Less than 4% taken to the Jail.

CORT received **2,669** LE reports in 2015; **823** follow up contacts conducted from those reports.

Average number of crisis screenings a month by PCC Staff: **445**

Jail Diversion Case Management clients provided resources in 2015: **127**
