I would like to express my concerns if HB 2004-A is approved and voted into law. We manage close to 450 units in Central Oregon and I have been sharing this proposed bill with several of my owners and all of them have stated that if this passes they will be selling their rental properties and moving their investments to a different state. If the last two weeks I have already seen this start to happen due to the House approving this bill. We have already lost 27 rentals from our management due to this proposed bill.

If HB 2004-A does pass we will lose even more homes and will create a greater strain on the rental housing market. We are already less than 1% vacancy and with this Bill passing there will be several families with no options for housing.

Please understand that by passing HB 2004-A we will have families living on the street, cars etc. because there will be no housing available.

I have shared my concerns several times without a response for anyone. Please confirm that you have received this email.
