As you may already be aware, House Bill 2027 is scheduled to have a public hearing this **Wednesday, May 10th** at 3pm in Salem.

HB 2027 would prohibit a person, public body or local service district from constructing bridges on the Deschutes River within certain segments of the Deschutes Scenic Waterway (this includes the riverfront property our community owns in SRV).
