#### HB 2056, with amendment House Revenue Committee Hearing May 11, 2017

Chair Barnhart, Representatives of the House Revenue Committee, thank you for the opportunity to speak.

I am Suzanne Kelso, President of Specialty Cigars in Bend, OR. We operate a retail store in Bend and a wholesale business focused on supplying the golf industry with cigars. We have customers across the state and across the nation. We employ 9 people in Oregon.

I am also the President of the Oregon Premium Retail Tobacconists Association, <u>Pipe and Cigar</u>

<u>Retailers in Oregon</u>. We estimate there are 75 specialty tobacconists in Oregon, employing 500 people in Oregon – small family owned businesses.

Specialty Cigars does not sell cigarettes, <u>we only sell cigars and pipe tobacco</u>. <u>Both are legally sold on the internet</u>, <u>so we are competing in a Nation-based Economy</u>. Pennsylvania and Florida have no cigar tax, and consequently the internet houses are based in those states. Oregon Cigar and Other Tobacco Tax Rates directly impact our ability to compete against these National Internet competitors.

We oppose HB 2056, including amendments: we have significant concerns with raising the tax rate, even if the cigar cap remains in place. A movement is already underway to introduce a ballot measure that would remove the cigar tax cap. In addition, we oppose the expansion of authorized taxing agents to include Municipalities.

The Forbes 2016 Ranking of Best States to do Business ranks Oregon #40 in Regulatory Environment.

Passing this bill will create redundant and expensive reporting requirements across multiple jurisdictions and make an already burdensome regulatory environment far worse for small businesses in Oregon.

- 1. HB will erode our customer base. Our customers have options! It is legal to buy cigars and pipe tobacco on the internet.
  - a. Our customers can buy cigars on the internet without State or County Tobacco taxes. We will lose sales to the internet.
    - Pipe Tobacco We only pay \$900/year in pipe tobacco because our pipe tobacco COST at 65% tax rate is more than it is sold on the internet! Comparison is attached.
    - Cigars Our retail store pays \$12,500/year in cigar tax at the cap. We pay a total of \$37,000 per year when including our wholesale business. These are INBOUND taxes, meaning we pay the tax at the time of buying inventory. We do not recover this tax until we sell the inventory to the public which can be months! It ties up precious cash! Increase the rate as per HB 2056, or expand the authorized taxing authorities per the amendment, and you will reduce the cash we have for employees and cause us to lose our business to the internet.
      - o If the rate is increased, our COST will be greater than the internet retail. Comparison is attached.

- 2. <u>HB 2056 will increase complexity of tax reporting and add regulatory compliance burden</u> on an already over-burdened small business community.
  - a. We are Family Owned, Specialty Stores. <u>Municipal reporting and varied tobacco tax</u> rates will introduce significant burden (paperwork and cost). This will increase the cost of running our business, in addition to an increase in tax burden.
  - b. Stores located in multiple municipalities will face a nightmare of proving tobacco tax as inventory is shared across county lines.
- 3. <u>HB 2056 creates uncertainty of tax burden</u> unpredictable tax environment undermines confidence and reduces willingness to invest in Oregon.
  - a. This Bill introduces significant uncertainty, that could (and likely will) lead to doubling the tobacco tax burden of small businesses throughout Oregon. Expansion of small shops to become multi-site stores would be impacted, as each shop owner will be faced with a different set of playing rules if they cross County lines.

Reduced Sales will lead to a reduction in State Tobacco Tax Revenue. HB 2056 may create a temporary increase to County coffers, but the cost will be significant, in lost State Tobacco Tax Revenue and in reduced employment opportunities.

Please say No to HB 2056 - this is a small business issue. We will lose our customer base to the internet, the State will lose revenue.
