## Equity Fund: Background

- In 5 Oregon counties, the majority of 0-5 year olds are children of color
- 36.5 % of babies born in Oregon are children of color



- Oregon's children of color continue to experience gaps in access and opportunity
- Oregon currently does not invest intentionally in early childhood programs designed and led by communities of color



## Equity Fund: Opportunity



- HB 3069 creates an Early Childhood Equity Fund to invest in culturally specific early childhood programs that are *getting positive results* for kids and families of color
- Consider these results from Latino Network's Juntos Aprendemos program:
- ✓ 90% of children make measurable gains in kindergarten readiness skills
- ✓ 90% of parents report significant changes in family literacy activities and parent engagement
- Organizations led by communities of color in Oregon are poised and ready to close the opportunity gap:
