RE: Support for HB 2745B - Transit Funding

Chair and Vice-Chair of the Committee:

I am writing today to urge you to support the bill currently before the legislature, HB 2745B, which will give voters in Central Oregon a choice on whether their areas should fund a public transit system.

The Central Oregon Health Council supports HB2745. This legislation would enable the communities we serve, Jefferson, Crook, and Deschutes, to create and support the transportation needs as individual and unique as the counties themselves.

HB 2745B offers a number of benefits to our Central Oregon Communities. It gives them local control -- each city can choose the appropriate level of service, funding amount, and tool for funding transit in their community. It maximizes efficiency, by retaining regional management for the transit system, minimizing costs and optimizing streamlined and convenient service. It drives economic development, helping local companies attract workers by giving employees a public transportation option that saves time and money. Some communities may choose to ask voters to support funding initiatives, and other communities may not be ready any time soon. Giving Central Oregon communities the option to seek transit funding from voters is important to our region.

So please, encourage the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee to move HB 2745B forward, and support its passage in this session. Thank you for giving local control of future transit initiatives to the Central Oregon voters.
