Subject: SB 13 – Relating to Native American curriculum in schools

SB 13 directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to develop a curriculum for grades 4 through high school relating to Native American history and experience in Oregon. The curriculum will likely be developed for grades 4, 8, and one year in high school. ODE is to develop the curriculum with the assistance of Tribal governments, made the curriculum available to school districts, and provided related professional development. The bill also establishes content requirements for the curriculum for implementation in the 2019-20 school year. Reporting requirements are included.

The budget bill for ODE will include \$2.0 million for this with \$200,000 for ODE for curriculum development and professional development for teachers. Grants to the nine Tribal governments account for the remaining \$1.8 million.
