



## Health effects




Components of wood smoke





Reduce smoke emissions




Biomass fuel – pellets & biobricks

  - Woodstove curtailment

## 1) Funding for local communities to implement wood smoke reduction programs (continued)

- Expand education and outreach
- Pursue grants and matching funds



# Recommendations

## 2) Sustained funding for woodstove changeout programs

- In the past, have had one-time only grants:
  - American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (2009) - \$2M for Klamath Falls, Lakeview, Burns, Eugene, Springfield, Oakridge
  - Regional Solutions (2015) - \$1.5M – Klamath Falls, Lakeview



	2500	22.5	2.4	82.4
\$5M	1420	18	1.7	50
	4100	37	3.9	136.7

<sup>[1]</sup> Assuming a mix of partial rebates and full rebates, and the devices changed out are replaced with a mix of certified woodstoves, pellet stoves, and gas or electric heating appliances.

<sup>[2]</sup> Benzene, 15-PAH, and acrolein
