Expands definition of "supervising physician" to include persons licensed to practice osteopathy or podiatry in this state for purpose of supervising physician assistants.

- 5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 677.495 is amended to read:
- 6 677.495. As used in ORS 677.495 to 677.535, unless the context requires otherwise:
- 8 (1) "Physician assistant" means a person who is licensed in accordance 9 with ORS 677.505 to 677.525.
- 10 (2) "Practice agreement" means a written agreement between a physician
  11 assistant and a supervising physician or supervising physician organization
  12 that describes the manner in which the services of the physician assistant
  13 will be used.
- 14 (3) "Supervising physician" means a [physician licensed to practice medi-
- 15 cine under this chapter] medical or osteopathic physician licensed under
- 16 this chapter, or a podiatric physician and surgeon licensed under ORS
- 17 **677.805 to 677.840,** who supervises a physician assistant.
- (4) "Supervising physician organization" means a group of supervising physicians that collectively supervises a physician assistant.
