

Just as a reminder, remember that fresh, store-bought lead will be bright, and shiny. As will freshly melted and molded lead.

Lead that has oxidized (PbO2) and weathered will have a white powdery crust to it. This is how you can tell that this lead is authentic, from our rivers and has been in the environment for many years. No one ran out and bought lead to make their photos. That oxidized lead only comes from being in the river for at least a year or more. The flakier the lead gets, the more that gets into the environment and water to poison everyone and everything.
