WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands the circumstances under which the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) may enter into an agreement with an integrator. Declares an emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Need to limit scope
- Requirements of the measure are not mandatory

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Replaces the original measure.

BACKGROUND:

An “integrator” means an entity who enters into a contract with the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide information and transact business for ODOT. For example, an integrator may facilitate and complete titling and license plate transactions for a car dealership. Currently, integrators are limited to the electronic issuance of vehicle titles, immediate issuance of title and registration, and written and skills testing for driver licenses and permits, including commercial driver licenses. Additional activities could include processing junk and salvage titles, out-of-state dealer transactions, and registration renewals.
