Measure Description:

Modifies requirements relating to evacuation of residents of adult foster homes.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the House Committee on Rules.

House Bill 3273 modifies statutes related to the evacuation of residents of adult foster homes. The bill requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to:

- Consult with appropriate regulatory authorities to develop standards to ensure that each adult foster home is able to evacuate all residents within a specified period of time;
- Adopt rules governing the use of electronic monitoring devices by residents of facilities; and
- Adopt rules governing the conversion of a facility’s license from a long term care facility license to a residential care facility license and the regulation of the facility during the conversion period.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Department of Human Services. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
